## Primary teachers and principals vote for full-day strike action

NZEI Te Riu Roa principal and teacher members have both voted for full day strike action on August 15.

The decision sends a strong message to the Government that it is time to fix this crisis in teaching. There needs to be better investment in education so every child can reach their potential and we have enough teachers for every class, said NZEI lead principal negotiator Louise Green.


